About us

The nursery was established from a greenfield site in January 1986, it was levelled to within a very accurate gradient to enhance the drainage of the whole site as the possibilities for a fully water recycled site were taken into consideration already back then!!

A large despatch/potting building along with 8 tunnels for winter protection were erected also at the end of 1985.

The nursery went operational from early 1986, with the first sales being achieved later in the summer of that year.

The main reason why we started the nursery in the beautiful Wiltshire countryside was that a 100-mile radius would cover the exact area we intended, as we didn't want to be national.

The production was as it still is to date mainly Shrubs & Perennials; over the years we have seen other additions come and go.

All our liners are carefully selected from UK and continental growers for us to be able to achieve maximum growth within the designated OUTDOOR growing time, so no propagation is done on site.

Our main aim has always been to grow the plants naturally outdoors in soil based compost so they are as hardy and tough as one can expect and that also enhances shelf life tremendously once they leave our nursery.

Our plants are supplied to Garden Centres and landscape architects all with our own transport, again to achieve the highest possible standard of quality and personal service from start to finish.

The rest of the plants take cover during the winter in a very modern greenhouse structure that was build in 1997 which has a reclining roof and sides, so as soon as it warms up it can all be opened up to let some sunlight or rain in and when we've had enough rain or the night time temperatures drop to low, the roof gets closed up at the flick of a switch.

All this ensures that the plants will get to you in a hardy as possible state of growth to prevent late frost from doing too much damage.

Deliveries are made on a regular basis by our own transport on CC trollies.
